**REQUISITION MAPS
BY STOCK NUMBER**

Stock numbers are constructed as follows:

A. The first 5 characters consist of the map series number. When the series number is less than 5 characters, the 5th character is the letter X.

B. The remaining characters of the stock number are the map sheet number (see SHEET NUMBERING SCHEME).

Exceptions: (1) The words "ALL SHEETS" are used in lieu of sheet number if stock number is intended to identify all available sheets of map series. (2) The word "INDEX" is used in lieu of sheet number to identify the series index.

C. Examples: (SERIES U542)

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; colored.
 FORMAT: 1°N-S x 1°30' E-W; Transverse Mercator Projection; 10,000 meter India Zone grid.
 SYMBOLS: AMS.
 SOURCE: Compiled from various medium scale India and Burma and Survey of India maps; planimetric detail partially revised by photo-planimetric methods.
 CHARACTERISTICS: International, state a/o division (Burma), phak (Thailand), and province (China) boundaries delineated; relief indicated by contours (interval varies) and form lines augmented with shaded relief; spot heights in feet; roads classified by width, surface, and weatherability; railroads classified by gauge and number of tracks; populated places shown outlined to shape or by building symbols and classified according to population (areas of Burma & India) or by importance (areas of China, Indochina, Thailand); vegetation shown by tint; reliability diagram; glossary.
