


INDEX TO MAPS OF

REQUISITION MAPS
BY STOCK NUMBER

Stock numbers are constructed as follows

A. The first 5 characters consist of the map series number. When the series number is less than 5 characters, the 5th character is the letter X.

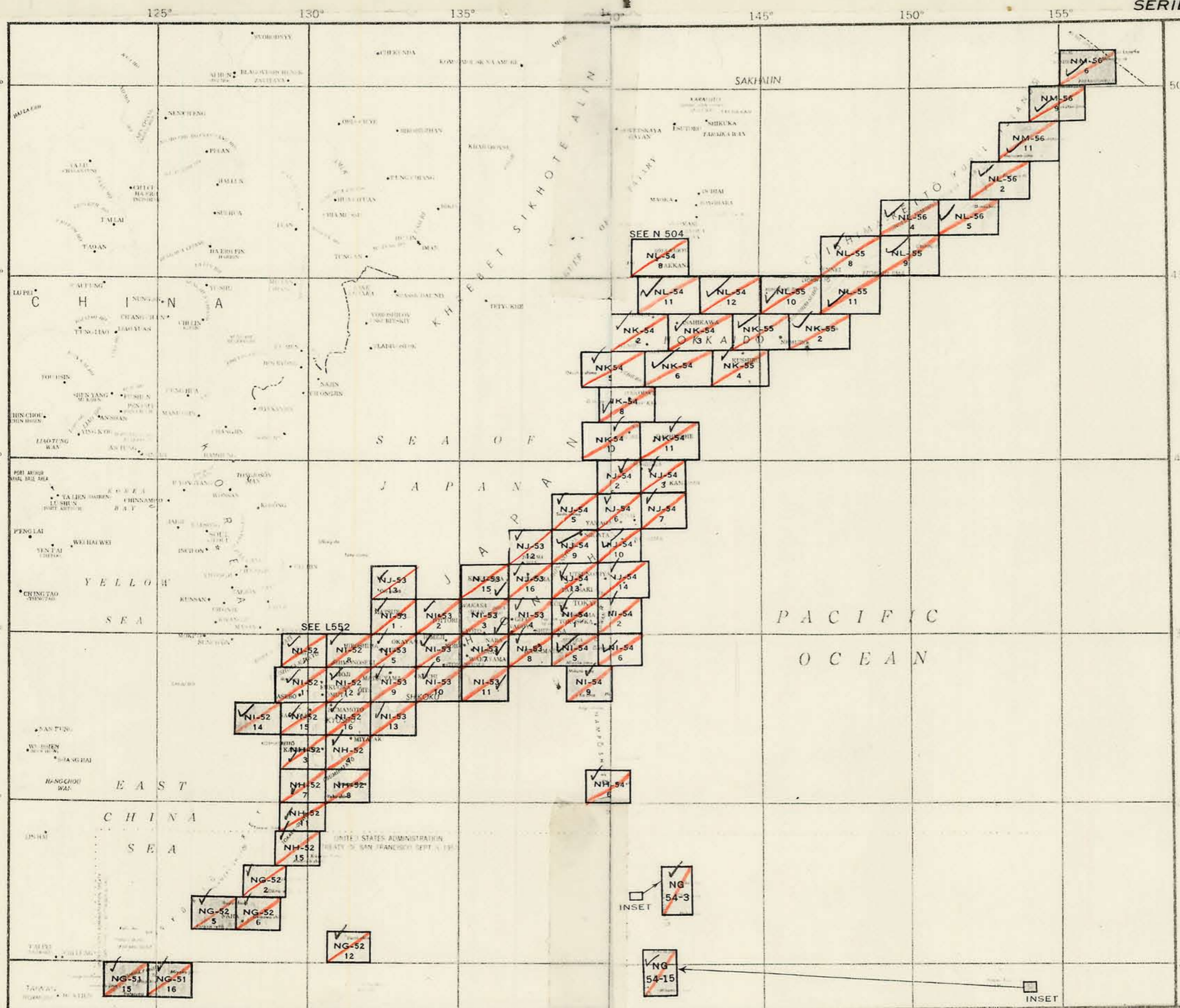
B. The remaining characters of the stock number are the map sheet number. Exceptions: (1) The words "ALL SHEETS" are used in lieu of sheet number if stock number is intended to identify all available sheets of map series. (2) The word "INDEX" is used in lieu of sheet number to identify the series index.

C. Examples: (SERIES L506)

SERIES DESCRIPTION

TYPE: Topographic; 6 colors.
 FORMAT: Sheet sizes vary; Transverse Mercator Projection; 10,000 meter UTM grid.
 SYMBOLS: AMS.
 SOURCE: Compiled mainly from AMS and Japanese 1:50,000 scale sources. Planimetry revised from 1947-1948 aerial photography and 1951 field check data incorporated on Japan proper sheets.
 CHARACTERISTICS: International and primary administrative (Ken and To) boundaries shown; relief indicated by definite contours (shaded for accentuation) at 100 meter intervals with supplementary contours at 50 meter intervals; heights in meters; populated places shown outlined in shape (with tint) and classified by population; roads classified by surface and weatherability; railroads classified by gauge; woodland shown by green tint; foreshore and offshore detail; names romanized in accordance with Modified Hepburn system; glossary.
