


INDEX TO MAPS OF

**REQUISITION MAPS
BY STOCK NUMBER**

Stock numbers are constructed as follows:

A. The first 5 characters consist of the map series number. When the series number is less than 5 characters, the 5th character is the letter X.

B. The remaining characters of the stock number are the map sheet number (see SHEET NUMBERING SCHEME).

Exceptions: (1) The words "ALL SHEETS" are used in lieu of sheet number if stock number is intended to identify all available sheets of map series. (2) The word "INDEX" is used in lieu of sheet number to identify the series index.

C. Examples: (SERIES N751)

 SOURCE: Compiled from large and medium scale Russian and German maps; planimetric detail revised by photo-planimetric methods.
 CHARACTERISTICS: International (pre-war 1937) boundary delineated; in addition, where necessary, an index to boundaries indicates post-war boundaries or limit of administration (not necessarily authoritative); relief indicated by contours at ten meter intervals with supplementary contours at five meters; spot heights in meters; populated places shown outlined to shape with tint or by building symbols; roads classified by width, surface, and weatherability; railroads classified by gauge and number of tracks; vegetation shown by tint; coverage diagram; glossary.
