**REQUISITION MAPS BY STOCK NUMBER**

Stock numbers are constructed as follows:

A. The first 5 characters consist of the map series number. When the series number is less than 5 characters, the 5th character is the letter X.

B. The remaining characters of the stock number are the map sheet number (see SHEET NUMBERING SCHEME).  
Exceptions: (1) The words "ALL SHEETS" are used in lieu of sheet number if stock number is intended to identify all available sheets of map series. (2) The word "INDEX" is used in lieu of sheet number to identify the series index.

C. Examples: (SERIES Y503)

**SERIES DESCRIPTION**

TYPE: Topographic; 6 colors plus altitude tints.  
 FORMAT: Most sheets 1° N-S x 1°30' E-W; Transverse Mercator projection; UTM or East Africa 10,000 meter grids.  
 SYMBOLS: British.  
 SOURCES: Compiled by D/Survey; the Lands and Surveys Dept., Uganda or the Survey of Kenya from large and medium scale maps and aerial photography.  
 CHARACTERISTICS: International and internal administrative boundaries delineated; relief indicated by contours or form lines at 200 or 500 foot intervals, augmented by altitude tints; heights in feet; populated places classified by importance into six classes and native settlements; roads classified as hard-surface all-weather roads, loose-surface all-weather roads, dry-weather roads, tracks suitable for wheeled traffic, other tracks; railroads shown as meter or light gauge; power lines and pipelines shown; airports and landing fields symbolized; perennial and intermittent streams, and lakes, wells, springs, water holes, boreholes, and pans shown; vegetation indicated in 3 categories by green tint, symbols or by notes.
